# 8 EXPRESIONES AVANZADAS EN EL MUNDO DE LOS NEGOCIOS EN INGLÉS CON SUS EJEMPLOS:

Today, we´re going to learn **8 useful expressions in English** that will be super helpful for you **at work, or in any professional environment!**

- To stay on top of (something): Mantenerse al tanto

We usually use this to mean "to not fall behind in your work" or "to be in control of your work"

## **Try and put an example:**

- To get the ball rolling: Poner manos a la obra  
We usually use this expression to mean: "To start a project"

## **Try and put an example:**

- Circle back = volver

This expression is very common when you want to "get back to someone" or hear what they have to say later.

## **Try and put an example:**

- To brainstorm - Hacer una lluvia de ideas

When we want to think of a lot of ideas for a certain project or objective, it's very common to use the word "to brainstorm."

## **Try and put an example:**

- Going forward - De ahora en adelante

This expression is extremely common, especially in emails, when expressing what changes will happen "from now on" in the future (whether it be your boss correcting you, or someone stating future changes in the company)

**Try and put an example:**

- Down the line - Más adelante

This expression is very common when speaking about a certain project, or goal that needs to be reached at some future occasion.

**Try and put an example:**

- Touch base - ponerse en contacto

To "touch base" is to get in contact with someone, usually briefly.

**Try and put an example:**

- Cut corners - Tomar atajos

We use this expression when someone does their work carelessly, or doesn't do crucial steps of a task due to their laziness.

**Try and put an example:**
